**VARIETALS:** 100% Chardonnay

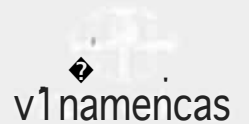
**AGEING:** French oak barrel fermentation, aged 8 months on the lees, then 5 more months in new French oak.

**ALCOHOL:** 14%

**TASTING NOTES:** Pale gold with hints of green. Voluptuous body with aromas of buttered toast and creme brulee. Firm structure with a melange of citrus, treacle toffee, melon and a hint of ginger. The finish is seamless and lingers long after the last drop.

**PRODUCTION:** 12,000 bottles

### ABOUT THE STELLENBOSCH REGION

Stellenbosch is perhaps the most famous wine-producing region in South Africa. The town, in Western Cape's Coastal Region, is steeped in history and is home to the country's best-known wine estates. Granite and sandstone soils are found throughout Stellenbosch. Their high clay content means that while they are free-draining, they have excellent water retention properties. Sufficient rainfall in winter allows growers to keep irrigation to a minimum.
